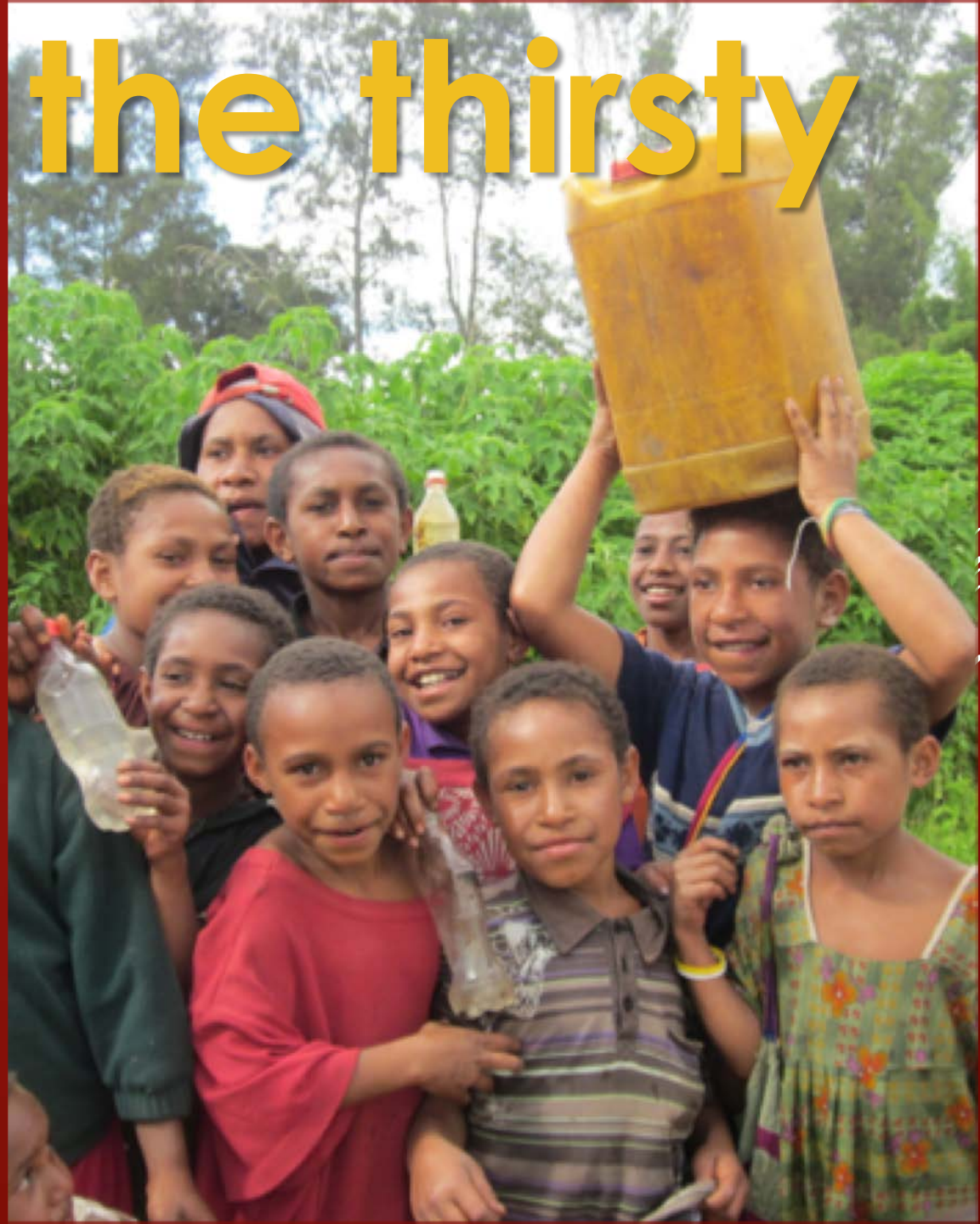




# give drink to the thirsty

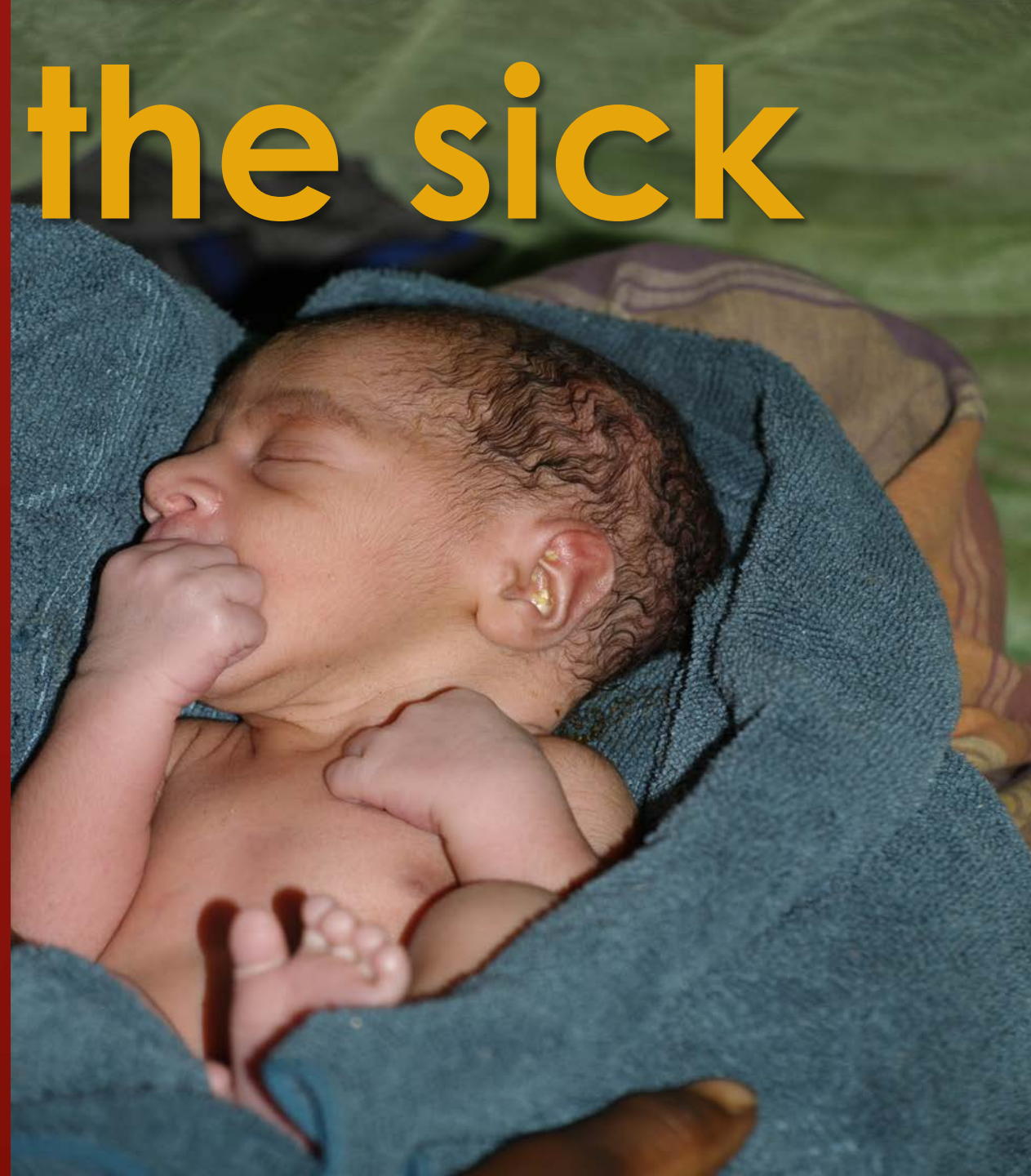


Mercy House of

a loved one.

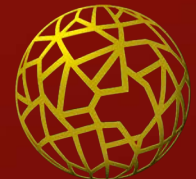
